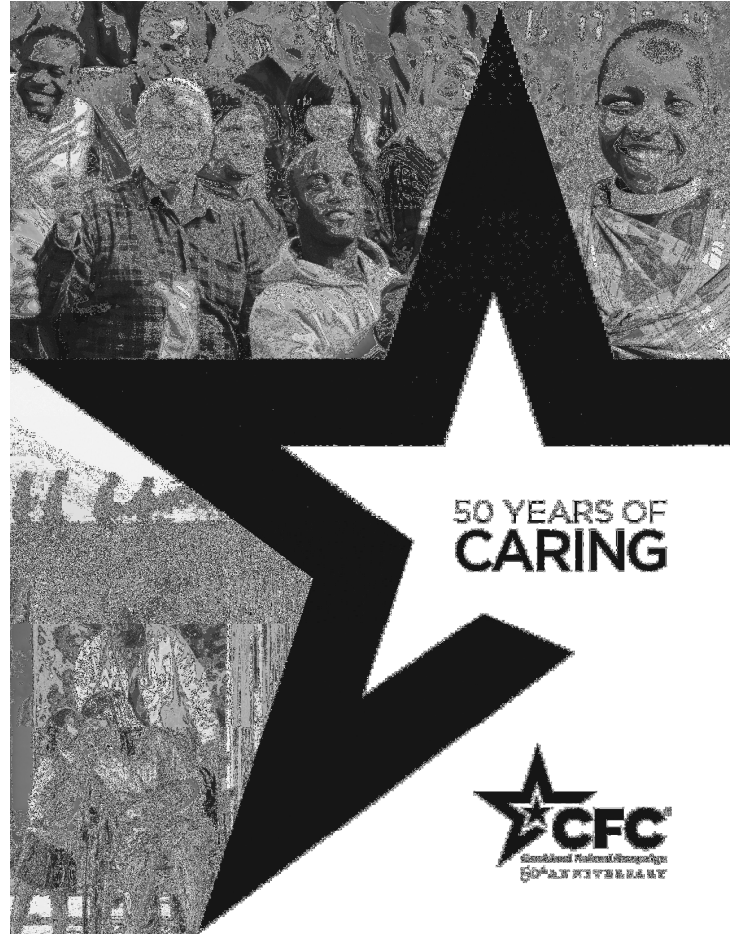


## Filling Out Your Pledge Form

1. Print or type your name and contact information in the top two rows. *The only copy which will show your social security number is the copy for your payroll department.*
2. In the AMOUNT column, fill in the amount per month or per pay period you wish to donate. *If this is a cash/check donation, skip to Step 4.*
3. In the TOTAL GIFT column, fill in the total amount of your 2011 CFC donation. *This must equal your monthly contribution x12 or your pay period contribution x 26.*
4. Enter up to 5 FIVE-DIGIT CHARITY CODES to which you wish to donate. *Codes found in the 2010 CFC Charity List, which is online at [www.siouxempirecfc.org](http://www.siouxempirecfc.org).*
5. Enter the ANNUAL AMOUNT of the donation you wish each charity to receive. *The sum of these amounts must equal your TOTAL GIFT.*
6. Complete RECOGNITION OPTIONS if you wish to release your contact information and/or gift amount to your designated charities.
7. SIGN YOUR PLEDGE FORM.
8. Tear off the back copy for your records before turning in your pledge form to the payroll office.
9. Let your agency's campaign manager know if you wish to receive recognition for your donation.

Designations can be made to over 30 local charities, as well as hundreds of national and international charities.

## 50 Years of Caring for our Communities



\$3.85/pay period can be a coffee, or provide:  
2 wigs to cancer patients which will increase their quality of life.  
1 month long mentor match to help a child do better in school, have better relationships and engage in positive activities.



\$19.23/pay period can be a movie out, or provide:  
3 children with a package of food each weekend during the school year, so they can have nutritious foods over the weekend.  
83 hot and nutritious meals to a homebound older adult, so they can maintain their independence.



\$38.46/pay period can be dinner out, or provide:  
4 months of help to an individual with a disability achieve employment and independent living.  
44 children with one book each month for a year, to increase their vocabulary.
